The Lewiston-Nez Perce County Regional Airport is a vital — and growing — part of the regional economy.

Air traffic continued to gain altitude during the first two months of 2018, according to the local air traffic control tower. Takeoffs and landings hit 1,690 in January and 1,613 in February of this year, constituting year-over-year increases of 67 percent and 20 percent, respectively. Airport Manager Stephanie Morgan said the 72,848 people who boarded airlines in 2017 represents an all-time high.

"That's five percent higher than the 2016 record of 69,693," she said, "and that doesn't include several thousand who took advantage of the casino flights or athletic charters." The airport recently added four new direct flights to Salt Lake City, with connections anywhere in the world.
