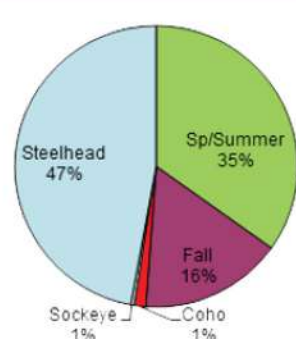
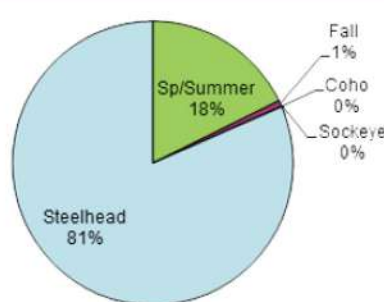

34% increase of reestablished native salmon varieties including coho, spring, summer, and fall chinook, and sockeye

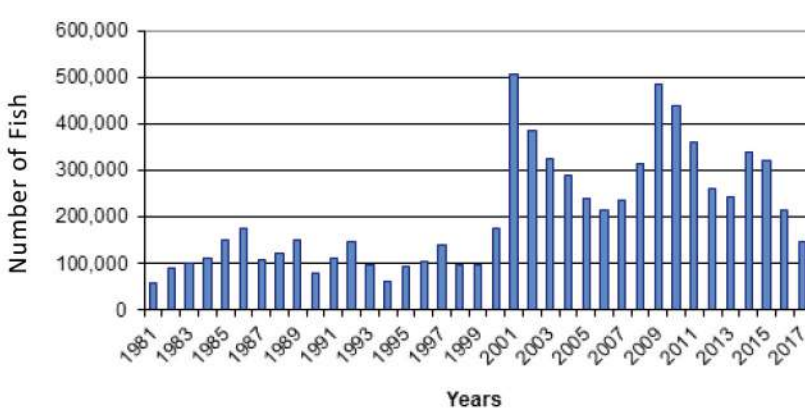
Composition over Lower Granite Dam

After NPT Involvement: 2016

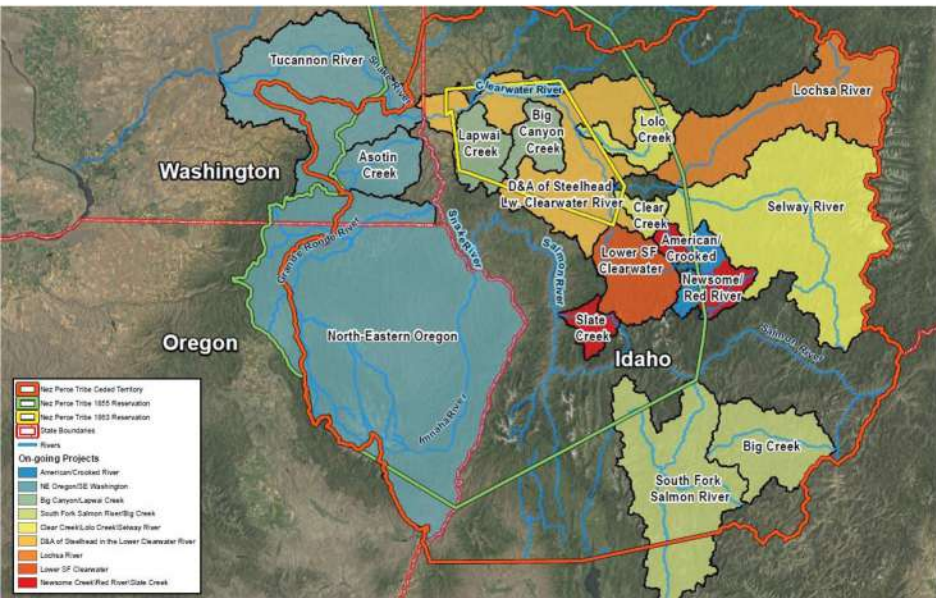
Returns over Lower Granite Dam - all species



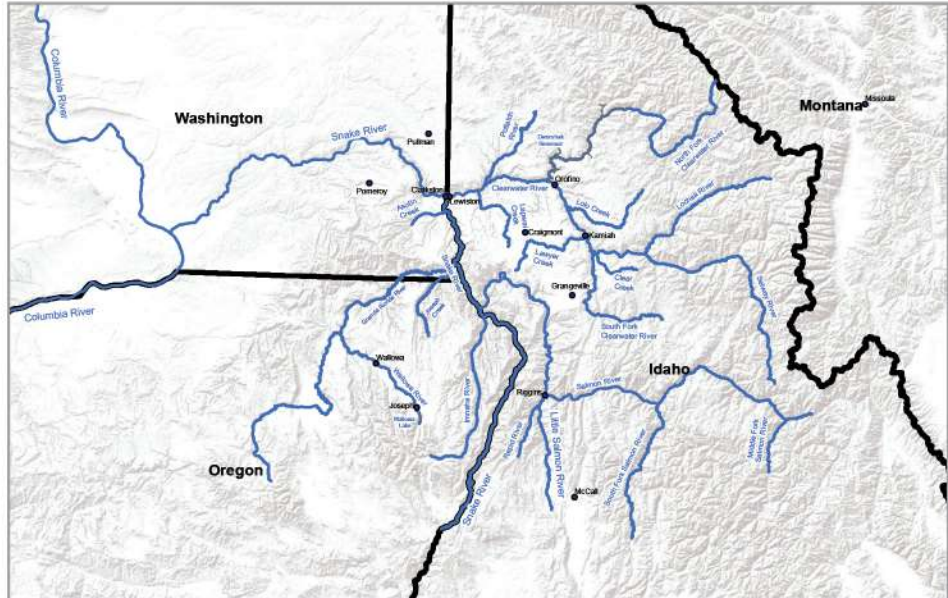
