


Palouse Ice Rink

The Palouse Ice Rink in Moscow has officially opened! This state-of-the-art facility held their Grand Opening Gala on October 28 at their new facility located at 2019 S Main Street in Moscow, Idaho. Idaho Central Credit Union is proud to be a major sponsor in helping to remodel the former NRS building into a full-size ice rink.

Palouse Ice Rink's previous facility was built at the Latah County Fairgrounds in 2002. The need for a larger, more comprehensive facility become apparent when the popular recreational rink began to attract more than 35,000 patrons a year. The community band together to raise funds and purchase the former NRS building at a significantly discounted price. Idaho Central was new to Moscow and recognized the opportunity to partner with such an iconic building that would meet the needs of hockey leagues, skating clinics, figure skating competitions, and the Science on Ice Program. The new 42,000 square-foot facility has a enough space for a full size sheet of ice along with locker rooms, restrooms, and a classroom.
